Subject Wanted by HCSO and Hanover Fire Marshal's Office

Hanover, VA – The Hanover County Sheriff's Office and Hanover Fire Marshal's Office are requesting the public's assistance in locating Tyrone Lamont Smith, Jr., 22, of Ashland. Smith is currently wanted by the Fire Marshall's Office for Threats to Bomb.

This charge stems from an incident that took place on December 31, 2016. On this date, Smith threatened to bomb a business located in the 8000 block of Creighton Parkway after an argument with an employee.

Smith is believed to be in the Metro Richmond area.
